WHO CAN GET HELP?

We can help victims of family violence, including spouses, people living together, parents, children, and people related by blood or adoption.

If you have been assaulted or think you or a loved one are in immediate danger, call **911** right away to get help from law enforcement.

WHAT IS FAMILY VIOLENCE?

Family violence can take many forms:

- Injury to family members or damage to property intended to intimidate or harm a family member
- Forced confinement
- Sexual abuse
- Stalking
- Any act or threat that causes a family member to be afraid for their safety or property, and is intended to intimidate or harm someone



WHAT KIND OF HELP CAN I GET?

If you are scared for your safety, there are different ways to get help, no matter how much money you have. We can help you obtain an Emergency Protection Order, connect you with other agencies, help you in court, and even set you up with a safety plan.
