WHAT KIND OF HELP CAN I GET?

Legal Aid Alberta may provide representation in a number of areas within Family Law.

These areas include:

- Child protection/child welfare matters
- Representation of children
- Parental custody, access, parenting orders, contact orders and guardianship
- Child support
- Spousal support
- Hague Convention applications
- Separation and divorce
- Matrimonial property disputes

If you have been assaulted or think you or a loved one are in immediate danger, call 911 right away to get help from law enforcement.

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

Call us to apply at 1.866.845.3425 and complete an assessment to determine your eligibility. Please have your personal I.D. (e.g. driver's licence) with you.

You may also be asked for your most recent paystub, bank statements, or income support statements, to help determine your financial eligibility.
